**This is for all NEW and for those CURRENTLY serving in this ministry.**

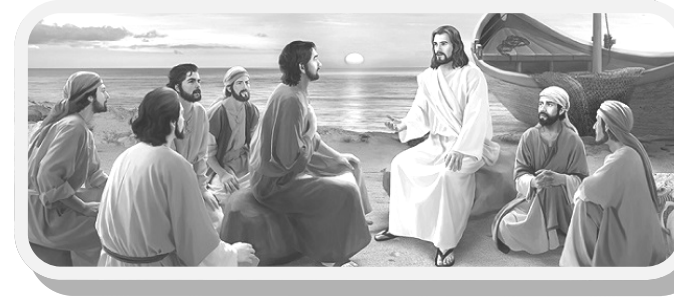
**YOU ONLY NEED TO ATTEND ONE SESSION:**
